

## Vision Secondary Intake Plate Instructions

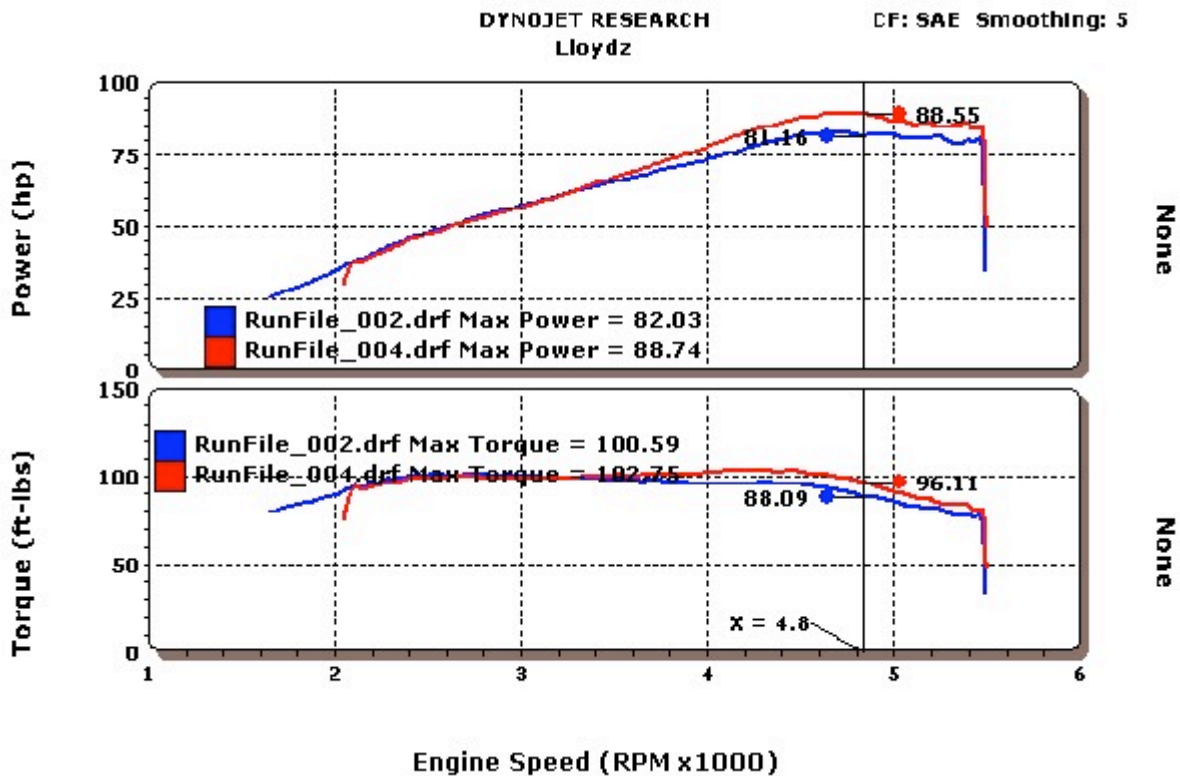

Tools required. 4mm Allen wrench, 6mm Allen Wrench, 10mm Socket,  
Approximate time to install ½ hour.

The removal of the center control panel and gauge cluster bezel is needed to install the intake plate. Remove the V shaped panel in front of the seat followed by the Center Panel. Disconnect the harness attached to the bottom of the center panel and lay it over on a soft cloth, complete removal isn't necessary. Then remove the Gauge Bezel, It maybe necessary to gently pry the bezel at one end to pop it from the mounting posts.

Once these items are out of the way remove the module box (2 Bolts) and the 6 bolts holding the plate to the frame. Remove plate and replace it with the intake plate, Re install 6 bolts carefully tightening them until all are snug and secure. The 4 bolts supplied in the kit are for the 4 rear bolt hole locations.

**Experience up to 7 Hp and 8 ft lbs of torque increase @ 4800 RPM's with no other changes  
Blue lines are before and red lines after intake install, A big gain for small \$\$\$**



Apply a thin layer of Form A Gasket to the bottom of the intake plate before installing.  
The top of the plate has the steps needed for the cable holding clamps.
